**LICENSING ACT 2003 APPLICATION: WHITE SWAN, EGGINGTON ROAD, HILTON**

In reference to the above application, please take this letter as formal notification that it is the intention of the Council to object to this application on the following grounds:

hours applied for are likely to impact upon Licensing objectives, namely:

The prevention of Crime and Disorder  
The prevention of Public Nuisance.

1. While it is accepted that the style, concept and location are not high risk, there are still Police concerns owing to the very large geographical area covered by Swadlincote Police section and the limited Police resources available, the Section Inspector fears that he may not have the resource to deal with incidents at Licensed premises during the proposed later hours, particularly at the weekends when a proportion of the available resources are diverted to Derby City centre to deal with issues there.
2. There are concerns that, if premises enjoy substantially later hours, such as those proposed, there is a likelihood of customers being attracted to the premises from outlying areas, thereby increasing the risk of disorder and nuisance which may in turn have an adverse impact upon the standing of premises in the local community,
3. There is also a commitment to providing Community Police Officers which is being driven by the Home Office, if there is a proliferation of late night venues then there is a risk that these officers will have to be re-deployed to other roles to cover issues at Licensed premises, this will be to the detriment of the wider community of South Derbyshire.
4. Insufficient information has been provided as to how the four licensing objectives are to be addressed (Guidance has been enclosed to assist in this).

information is included as to how the external drinking area is to be managed.

suggested that a terminal hour of Midnight for Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday & Thursday and Saturday and Sunday is more manageable for the Police resources available and is consistent with indications received to date.

Following an assessment of the premises and its surrounding area the following is proposed:  
30 minute "drinking up" time will allow appropriate dispersal, use of lavatories etc  
In order to further the licensing objectives the licensee reserves the right to move the fire appliances, AWP machines, cigarette machines and or any other similar objects temporarily in a fixed location which may impact on the ability of individuals on the premises to use exits or escape routes without impediment.

**b) The prevention of crime and disorder**

Internal & external cctv system in place, good lighting to car park & external areas in this outskirts of village location. No other licensed premises in vicinity. Burglar alarm system in place. Toilets are monitored & checked regularly. Good range of soft drinks available for drivers.

**c) Public safety**

Current health & safety policy in place, regular glass collection policy, car park signs reflect 'do not drink & drive'. Registered first aider & first aid box on site, fire fighting equipment serviced & on site, emergency lighting & illuminated exit signs in evidence. Basic Hygiene certification in place. Disabled toilet facilities available, designated no smoking areas. Fire alarm on site.

**d) The prevention of public nuisance**

External signage 'please leave premises quietly', however nearest domestic residence is c. 300 yds away. There are no other pubs in the immediate vicinity and the site has double glazed window units in the majority of the pub. Lobbied entrance/exit helps retain any noise.

**e) The protection of children from harm**

Non smoking areas represent 80% of licensed premises, save for adults only bar area. No gaming machines other than in adults only bar area. Cigarette machine located in adults only area. Children allowed on premises accompanied by parent or guardian in designated areas only. Well enclosed garden area for family use, plastic bottled drinks available, plus plastic glassware if desired. 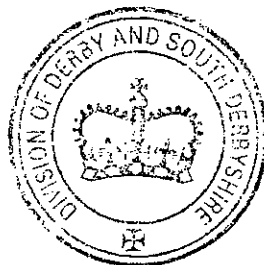
