APPLICATION TO VARY A PREMISES LICENCE UNDER THE LICENSING ACT 2003

Report of the Head of Housing and Environmental Services

1. PURPOSE

To consider an application to vary an existing premises licence held under the Licensing Act 2003 at Rosliston Village Hall, Main Street, Rosliston, Derbyshire, DE12 6RU (application attached at Appendix 1).

The application was received by the Licensing Authority from Brian Matkin on behalf of Rosliston Village Hall on the 11th January 2011.

Brian Matkin gave the Licensing Department written consent to consult with the Chairperson of the management committee, Heather Hooper in relation to the application. (Appendix 2).

The location of Rosliston Village Hall is shown outlined in yellow on the plan (Appendix 3).

2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1 The original application for a premises licence under the Licensing Act 2003 was received on 22nd March 2006 from Mr Peter G Greenwood. The application was granted on the 2nd May 2006.
- 2.2 Details of licensable activities are indicated below.

3. EXISTING LICENCE

- 3.1 The current premises license (Appendix 4):
 - The Provision of Regulated Entertainment for: plays, films, indoor sporting events, live music, recorded music, performances of dance and anything of a similar description to live music, recorded music, performances of dance;
 - The provision of entertainment facilities for making music and dancing.

The times the licence authorises the carrying out of licensable activities are:

Monday to Saturday Sunday

08.00hrs until 23.00hrs 09.00hrs until 22.30hrs

4.1 In the application for variation of the premises licence, it is requested that the hours be extended for all requested licensable activities at 3.1 above on Friday and Saturday until 24.00hrs.

- 4.2 Additionally the application requests that the hours be extended for all requested licensable activities on New Years Eve/ Day to finish at 00:30 hrs
- 4.3 If the application is approved it has been requested that the opening hours for the premises will be open to the public: -

Monday to Thursday Friday and Saturday Sunday

08.00hrs until 23.00hrs 08.00hrs until 24.00hrs 09.00hrs until 22.30hrs.
