I oppose the granting of a premises licence for No 50, Derby Road, Melbourne, on each of the Licensing Objectives listed on the application on the basis that when the premises were operated by the Liberal Club each objective was at some stage or other permitted by the appropriate authority. The residential nature of the neighbourhood was totally ignored and the noise generated by children playing in the street (they were not permitted in the grounds at the rear) and by departing guests was intolerable.

A closing hour beyond 2300 hours is offensive as is the supply of alcohol to meet such times. I have no objection to the addition of either live or recorded music when the bar is open but think that there needs to be installed a system of noise monitoring as has been a feature of the Alma Public House. Such a means of observation ought to be in place before any licence is issued.

The suggested supply of Late Night Refreshment only leads to a further source of noise and disturbance and should not be permitted.

In general terms Melbourne has need for the facility now sought providing it is strictly monitored and causes no offence to the community.

If possible please suggest alterations to the application that would resolve the problem mentioned above, again paying attention to the licensing objectives
