1. PURPOSE

1.1 To determine an application to vary a premises licence received by this Authority on the 23rd March 2018 from Tesco Stores Ltd. The application is attached at **(Appendix 1)**.

2. BACKGROUND

2.1 The applicant is seeking a full variation to a premises licence to change the hours for the sale by retail of alcohol and the current opening hours of the premises to the times stated in paragraph 3.

Tesco is a large national operator with a range of head office and local support. The company has devised policies, procedures, systems and training to ensure that they can sell alcohol in a responsible manner.

There is a detailed training programme which ensures that comprehensive training is provided to employees having regard to their role and the responsibilities and such training is regularly refreshed and appropriate records kept

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

The premises will have digital CCTV system that covers many areas of the shop floor, including the main area which will be used for display of alcohol,

Images will be retained for a minimum of 21 days

Ordinarily, a member of the Management team will be on the premises all the time the store is open. A person will have responsibility for the premises whilst the premises are open

c) Public safety

The premises licence holder is fully aware of its responsibilities under a range of health and safety related legislation and has appropriate policies and procedures in place to be confident of complying with the relevant obligations which arise

d) The prevention of public nuisance

In addition, the company has a "good neighbour" policy which seeks to ensure that the premises play an active part in the local community

e) The protection of children from harm

The premises will operate its own Think/Challenge 25 policy. As part of the underlying system all tills will be programmed to prompt the checkout assistant when an alcohol product is scanned at the till to follow the Think/Challenge 25 policy.

Staff will receive appropriate training both in relation to the underlying law but also the Tesco policy and systems and procedures. This training will be documented and repeated as often as Tesco believes to be appropriate.

Tesco Express, Common Road, Church Gresley

I was surprised to read a notice outside Tesco Express regarding the proposal for the shop to stay open until 11.00 p.m. each evening. As my house is next door to the shop, I would have thought I would have received notification by post of the proposed changes, which will affect me more than other neighbouring properties. Can you please explain why this is not the case.

I am most concerned by the proposal – surely 10.00 pm is quite late enough for the needs of most people?

I am worried that later opening hours will result in extra noise, slamming of car doors, etc., at a time when residents may well have already retired to bed. A considerable number of car owners find it easier to block my driveway (despite double yellow lines) when "popping" to the shop rather than using the car park at the rear of the property.

It also means that the shop will still be open when people leave local pubs for the night, which means they can purchase extra alcohol to drink on the way home, also with a greater potential for even more cans and bottles to be thrown into my garden.

In view of the above concerns, I would urge you to reject this proposal.
