I write in my capacity as the Senior Environmental Health Officer for the South Derbyshire District Council

Discussions have taken place with the application in relation to the promotion of the licensing objectives.

I understand that the applicant has formally amended their application to include the following conditions:

The applicant has satisfied me that the nature of the live amplified entertainment and the frequency with which it will occur is unlikely to cause nuisance to the general public, providing it is properly managed.

In the event that problems arise, Environmental Health has powers available under the Environmental Protection Act 1990 s80 to serve a noise abatement notice, and/or to call for the licence to be reviewed and conditions imposed restricting licenced entertainment.

On this basis, please accept this notice as formal notification to withdraw my representation to the above premises licence application. Furthermore, I confirm that I do not consider a hearing to be necessary.
