Following a complaint about the caravan a planning application was made for its retention. A number of objections were received. The application was refused under delegated powers for the following reason:

"The caravan has a severe impact on the estate farmland landscape of this part of the countryside, to the detriment of its character appearance, contrary to the approved Derby and Derbyshire Structure Plan General Development Strategy Policy 4 and the adopted South Derbyshire Local Plan Environment Policy 1 and Recreation and Tourism Policy 1."
