The premises are operated strictly in accordance with the Royal British Legion Club Rules which set out what constitutes misconduct by members and allows the Committee to expel members who are in breach of the rules or whose conduct is likely to bring the Club into disrepute.

- Local crime issues such as vehicle crime, pickpockets or bag snatchers
- Leaving bags unattended and where customers can report concerns to reduce the potential for terrorist incidents

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c) Public safety

The maximum number of persons on the premises engaged in licensable activities will not exceed 420. The Club will ensure that this capacity limit is not exceeded

The Club will arrange, once in every calendar year, or at such times as may be required on the advice of a relevant industry specialist, an inspection of all fire safety equipment, gas appliances, emergency lighting equipment and electrical installations.

The fire brigade will be called at once to any outbreak of fire, however slight and the details recorded in a fire log book.

The local Fire Control Centre will be notified as soon as possible if the water supply to any hydrant, hose reel, sprinkler, drencher or other fire extinguishing installation is cut off or restricted.

Access for emergency vehicles will be kept clear and free from any obstruction.

When disabled people are present, adequate arrangements will be provided to enable their safe evacuation in the event of an emergency and ensure that they are made aware of the arrangements

Exit doors will be easily opened without the use of keys, cards or similar means

An adequate and appropriate supply of first aid equipment and materials will be available on the premises

d) The prevention of public nuisance

No music or speech shall be relayed via external speakers, other than for events with the prior approval of the licensing authority.

The licensee or a nominated representative shall receive and respond to complaints throughout the duration of all noisy events

No fireworks or other pyrotechnics shall be used other than with the prior consent of the licensing authority.

Prominent, clear notices shall be displayed at all exits requesting customers to respect the needs of local residents and leave the premises and the area quietly.

in respect of the (same) club premises.

That no intoxicating liquor shall be sold in the club premises otherwise than to a person whose admission to the club premises is provided for by the rules of the club and, subject to S.49(4) Licensing Act 1964, the said rules shall not be altered without the consent of the Magistrates' Court upon application being duly made for that purpose so as to authorise sales not authorised at the time of the application for this certificate.
