5.0 Detail

5.1 Following a complaint from the Parish Council a site inspection was carried out at the above location.

5.2 It was ascertained that a second access to the Marina, via an underpass to the bridge over the river Trent had been closed by means of a locked gate.

5.3 This access was indicated on the approved plan when the Marina was established and its provision and availability was a requirement of the then Regional Controller for Highways and Transportation.

5.4 In view of the changed nature of traffic density on the A6 trunk road following the opening of the A50, the views of the Highways Agency were sought in the matter.

5.5 The Agency took the stance that, in view of the greatly reduced traffic flows on this section of road, enforcement action by the Council could not be supported.

- 5.6 The County Highways Authority was also consulted as it will be assuming responsibility for that length of highway when it is de-trunked on completion of the Alvaston bypass.
- 5.7 The Authority was of the opinion that there was no evidence of highway detriment caused by the closure of the access.
- 5.8 A plan of the site is attached at Annexe A.


8.1 None

- 9.1 Notwithstanding the original requirement that the access is to remain available for use, highway grounds for its retention would be of primary importance in justifying enforcement action.
- 9.2 In view of the fact that both highway authorities involved have offered no objection to the closure of the access enforcement action would not appear to be viable.
