#### 1. Recommendations

1.1 The Finance and Management Committee is asked to confirm the spending proposals set out within the Capital Programme for 2002/3 (Annexe A)

### 2. Purpose of Report

2.1 This report sets out the Council's capital spending proposals for next year 2002/3. These have been updated with information that has become available since my last report to Finance & Management in January.

#### 3. Detail

3.1 At its meeting on 17<sup>th</sup> January 2002, the Finance and Management Committee agreed capital spending proposals to be used for consultation purposes on the revenue budget. This included the following key points:-

Disabled Facilities Grants	233,000
Improvement Grants	491,500
Total Allocation	1,026,000

- 3.3 The results of this consultation have been reported to the Corporate Scrutiny Committee as part of its scrutiny of the Council's budget. A separate report of the Scrutiny Committee is set out elsewhere on this agenda.
