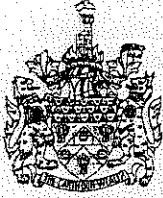

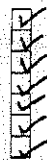

Q Promotion of Licensing Objectives

a) General

As previously stated the Coopers Arms stands in its own grounds, approximately 400-500 yards from the nearest dwellings. The operation is largely food orientated with provision for weddings, special occasions and business conferences, all of which are pre-booked. There has been no trouble in the past with any crime and disorder.

The Applicant will comply with the reasonable requirements of the Police Crime Reduction Officer.

b) The Prevention of Crime and Disorder

The Applicant will ensure that CCTV is installed following advice from the Derbyshire Constabulary Crime Reduction Officer and will be maintained in accordance with the relevant CCTV Code of Practice.

The Applicant and his staff operate a policy requiring production of Proof of Age in respect of any proposed sales where there is a suspicion that the customer is under 21. Such Proof of Age includes the PASS Accreditation system, photographic driving licence and passports.

The Applicant will not introduce or carry on any irresponsible sale promotion or discounting of prices of alcoholic beverages.

The Applicant will ensure that appropriate signs indicating normal trading hours during licensable activities will be displayed on or immediately outside the premises.

c) Public Safety

There is disabled access to the rear of the premises and the Applicant will ensure that when disabled people are present, adequate arrangements exist to enable a safe evacuation in the event of an emergency. Any such disabled customers will be made aware of those arrangements.

There is emergency lighting systems throughout the premises in the public areas.

Smoke and Fire alarms are fitted throughout all public areas.

The Applicant will continue to abide by the Standard Conditions attached to the Public Entertainments Licence in particular with regard to emergency procedures and exit routes; fire safety; fire resistant furnishings; staff training, etc.

A smoke ventilator is provided in the main bar and there are also fans throughout in most public areas.

d) Prevention of Public Nuisance

Bearing in mind the position of the premises at such a distance from residential dwellings, the playing of amplified music inside the premises should not, and has not, caused a nuisance to neighbours.

With regard to the playing of pre-recorded, amplified music outside, the volume control has been set at a level that should not cause a nuisance to neighbours and has been taped in position with instructions to staff not to alter the same.

The outside bar will close by 11pm.

The Applicant will install clear notices in the outside sales area and Beer Garden requesting customers to respect the need of local residents and to leave the premises quietly.

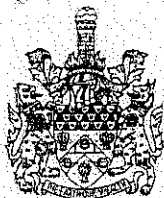
Staff have also been notified to leave the premises quietly at the end of their shift to respect the needs of local residents.

At busy times, the Applicant will ensure that two staff members are available to cater for the outside bar and in any event will ensure that the area is regularly visited by staff and tables cleared. Only plastic ashtrays will be provided outside.

e) Protection of Children from Harm

As previously stated, the Applicant operates a Proof of Age scheme in using Identity Cards.

There is also smoke ventilation in the main bar.

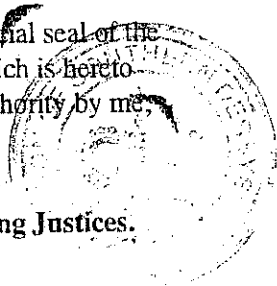

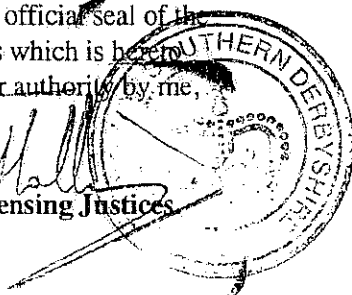
