

### Specification Information

- Tree species are to be protected with tubex plastic spiral guards or equivalent 600mm high, 50mm diameter, including 900mm cane & tie as per the Bill of Quantity.
- Shrub species are to be protected with slatguards, height 600mm, diameter 150mm with 900mm stake & tie as per the Bill of Quantity.
- Planting areas to be thoroughly cleared & prepared in accordance with the Bill of Quantity & Contract prior to planting operations. Soil Improvement / compost incorporation as per the specification.
- All species to be planted at a density of 1.5 metre centres in staggered rows. Transplants to be planted to achieve a random distribution of species in varying blocks of not less than 12 No. together. Shrub species to be predominantly positioned on the Northern edge of the area adjoining the mower strip.
- All Transplants (60-90cm) or Feathered trees (1.75x2.00m) to have a 50% 500mm wool mat or equivalent secured at the base.
