No fireworks or other pyrotechnics shall be used other than with the prior consent of the licensing authority.

Prominent, clear notices shall be displayed at all exists requesting customers to respect the needs of local residents and leave the premises and the area quietly.

Staff must be given adequate training to ensure they keep noise levels to a minimum when leaving the premises.

Disposal of waste bottles into external receptacles (where the noise will be audible to residents in the neighbouring properties) must not occur between 23:00hrs and 07:00hrs the following day.
