a) General - all four licensing objectives (b,c,d,e) (please read guidance note 15)

Following an assessment of the premises and its surrounding area the following is proposed:

30 minute "drinking up" time will allow appropriate dispersal, use of lavatories etc

In order to further the licensing objectives the licensee reserves the right to move the fire appliances, AWP machines, cigarette machines and or any other similar objects temporarily in a fixed location which may impact on the ability of individuals on the premises to use exits or escape routes without impediment.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

Externally well lit, active member of Pub watch, most customers are local and many are walk to customers. A wide range of soft drinks and non-alcoholic products available. Premises is protected by a security burglar alarm. Toilets and licensed area are regularly monitored by management/staff. Drink/drive posters clearly in evidence.

c) Public safety

Basic food hygiene and health & safety certificates in place. Registered first aid and first aid box in evidence. Fire alarm tested periodically, emergency lighting in evidence and illuminated signage above exits, compliant with smoking charter - separate areas, pest control contract in place, accident book in evidence, fire fighting equipment serviced & in evidence.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

Regular external checks made by the management during two in a bar entertainment. Fabric of the building retains sound well, no adjoining local residents. Property has entrance / exit lobbies to further retain sound. Cellar condensing unit is very new and emits very low noise levels. Encourage customers to leave quietly signage in place.

e) The protection of children from harm

No unaccompanied children allowed on site. Children accompanied by by an adult are allowed in a designated area, at the discretion of the licensee, until 9pm. In addition, the patio area is available for family useage, but strictly only accompanied children allowed. Plastic bottled drinks available for childrens consumption. No smoking allowed during food service times, in food service areas. Designated areas are well away from awp machines and cigarette machine.

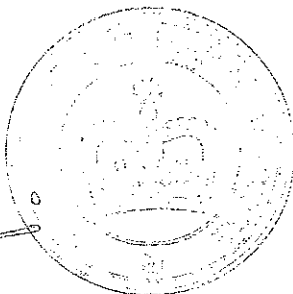
