	DECISION: That the contents of the East Staffordshire Local Plan "Preferred Option" be noted, and that East Staffordshire Borough Council be informed that: (I) the proposal to allocate sufficient sites to meet housing needs within the Borough, rather than attempting to rely on development at Drakelow Park in South Derbyshire addresses this Council's earlier objections, and is welcomed; (II) the reference at paragraph 6.37 to the likely availability of employment land at Drakelow be removed or clarified; (III) in other respects, the Preferred Option document is considered to reflect ongoing cross-boundary issues in line with the 'Duty to Co-operate' and the District Council would welcome further liaison.
