3.0 Purpose of Report

- 3.1 To advise of street naming proposals in Castle Gresley/Cauldwell.
- 3.2 A request has been received to provide a new road name for the already existing road which runs from the Cadley Hill island up to Cauldwell Road, Drakelow.
- 3.3 The suggested name is Cadley Lane.

The reason for the request is that the emergency services have encountered difficulties in locating properties on this stretch of road.
