2.0 Purpose of Report

2.1 To outline a possible request from Community Services Committee to use a maximum of £5000 of capital 'carryover' to fund further developments at the above site

3.0 Executive Summary

4.0 Detail

- 4.1 At their meeting of 11th April 2002, Community Services Committee considered a report outlining success in attracting external funding to the above project. This offer of funding is 'time limited', with work having to be completed by this August
- 4.2 However, this will only part fund the necessary development work. To maximise the benefit of the funding and to progress the scheme Member approval is sought to use a maximum of £5000 of a possible 'carryover' of the capital that was allocated in 2001/2002 to provide new play equipment and safety surfacing.
