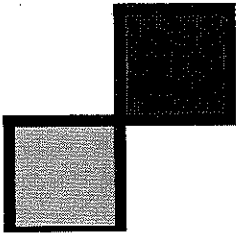


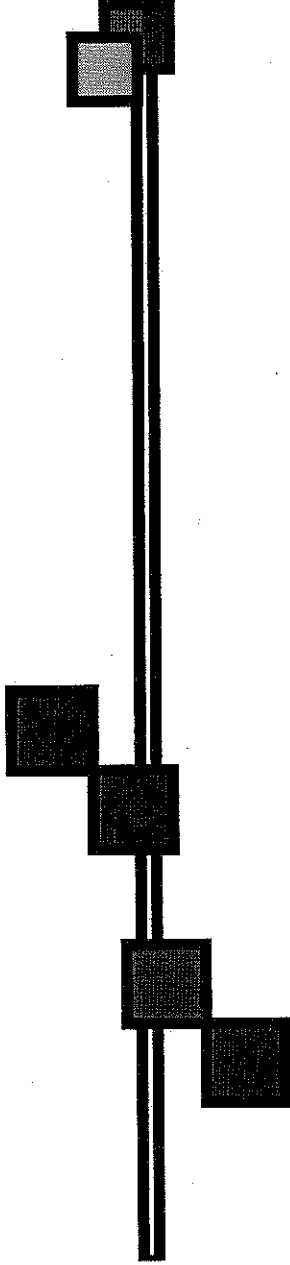
Theme 1: Safe Communities

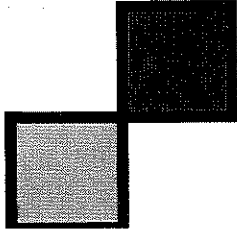

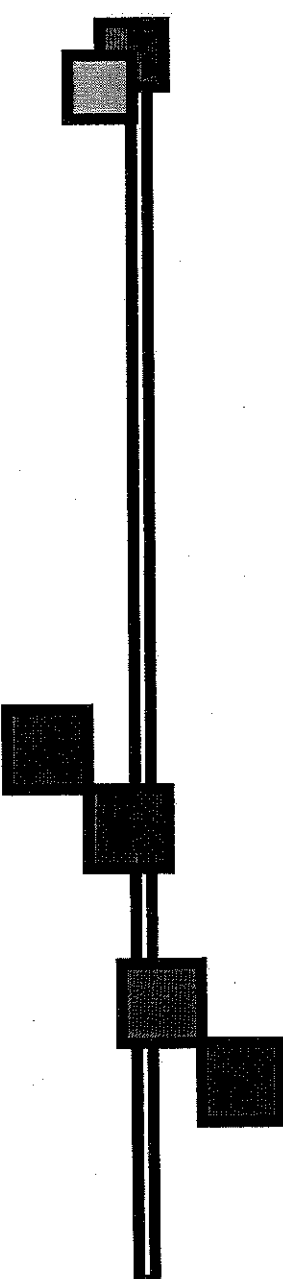

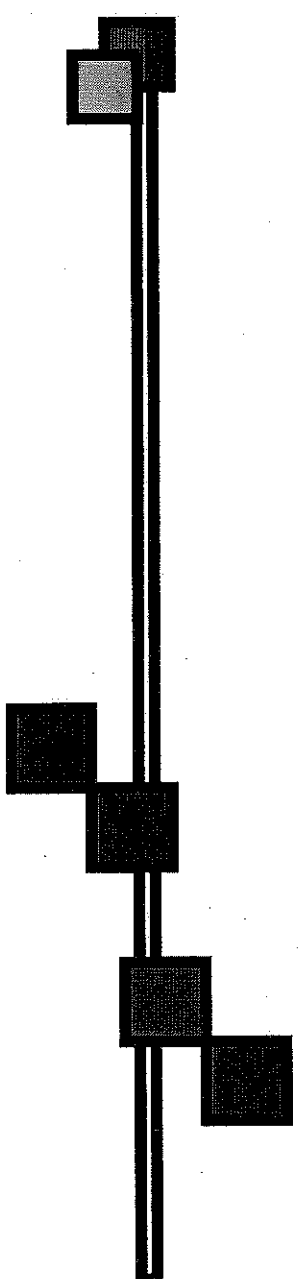


- Actions we might consider

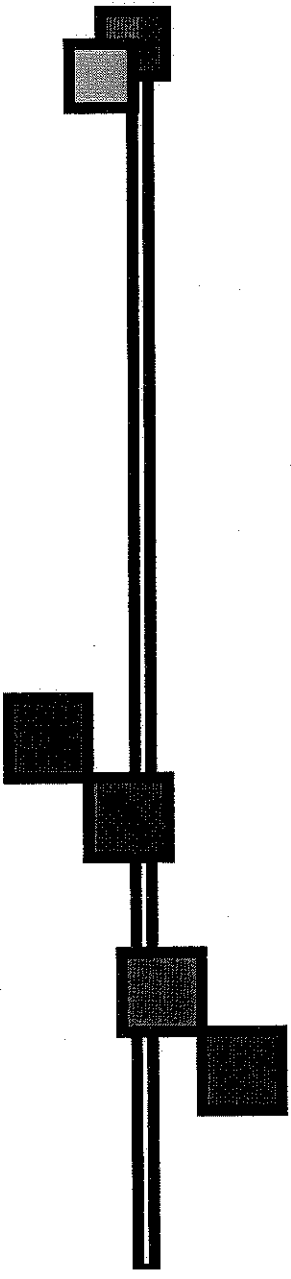


- Actions we might consider

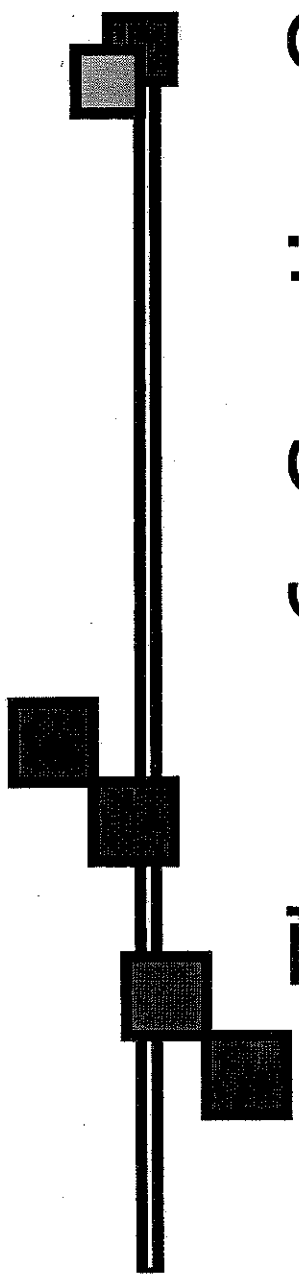


- Actions we might consider

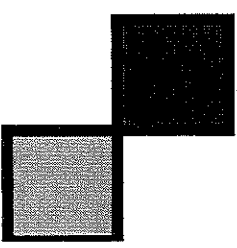


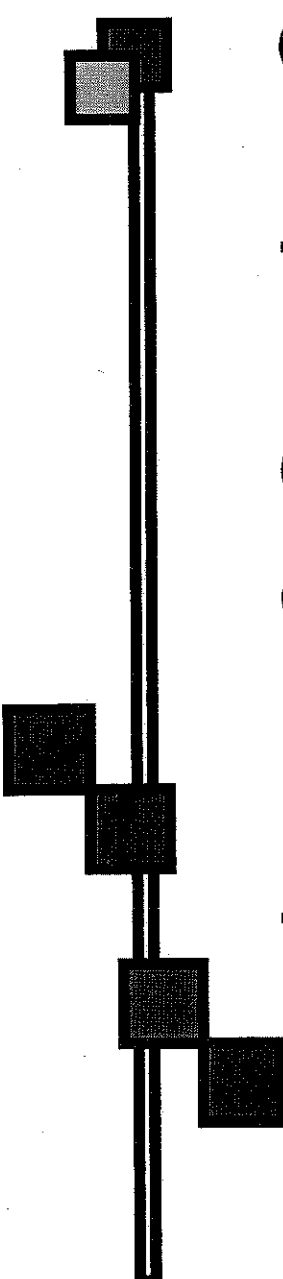
Theme 6: Creating Opportunities for All

 - Meeting the needs of homeless (and potentially homeless) families and individuals

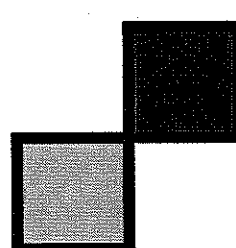

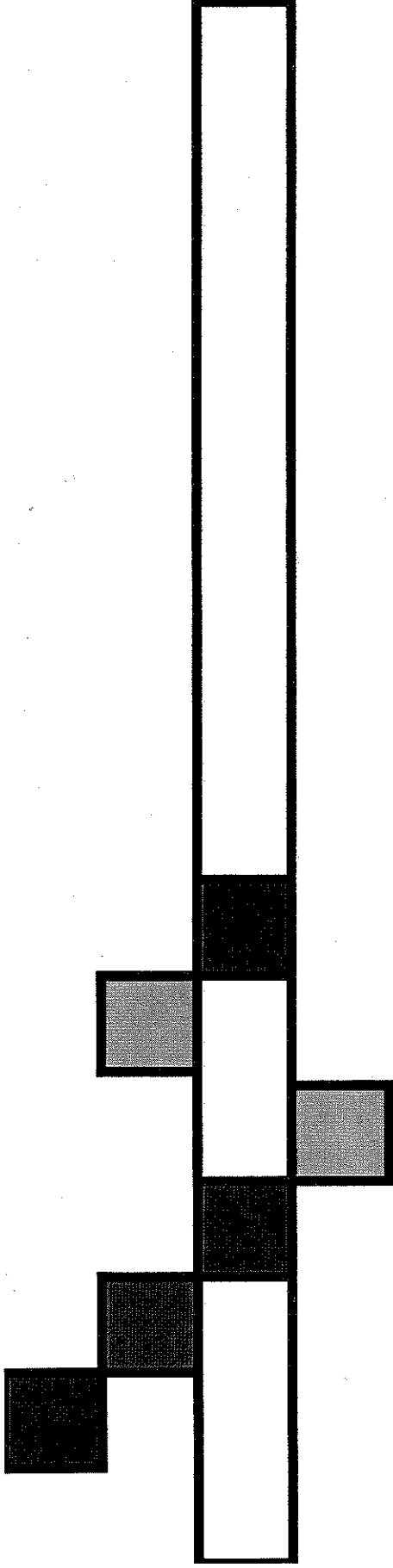
