2.0 Purpose of Report

2.1 To consider confirmation of this Tree Preservation Order.

3.0 Detail

3.1 This Tree Preservation Order was made on 20 March 2006 in respect of a Common Walnut located at 66 Castle Way, Willington.

The Order was made for the following reason:

'This walnut is a vigorous tree in fine form. The tree is a prominent feature on the edge of Willington, clearly visible from Castle Way, and is considered to be of particular amenity value in this location. In view of the amenity value of the tree the Council consider it expedient that the order is made.'

- 3.2 Comments have been received from the Diocese of Derby regarding the insensitivity of the Tree Preservation Order in view of the publicity regarding the possibility of the Primary Care Trust locating a suitable site for a surgery within the area.
- 3.4 In answer to the comments made officers have the following comments:
 - The Council consider that the Walnut Tree is of considerable amenity value and would seek to protect and preserve the tree in the light of any potential development of the site.
