2.1 To advise members of the facilities usage.

3.0 Detail

- 3.1 Attached at Annexe 'A' is a breakdown of public usage for the swimming pool, squash courts and tennis courts for the financial years 2002/03 to date.
- 3.2 Eleven candidates attended the first Amateur Swimming Association Level 1 Teachers Certificate course at Etwall over the Easter holidays. A Level 2 Course will be staged during the long school holiday period.
- 3.3 Our Children's Learn to Swim Programme has been extended to accommodate more pupils. Approximately 590 pupils now attend lessons each week with 360 on the waiting list.
- 3.4 The first Children's Learn to Swim Programme Gala was held in February. A questionnaire is being sent out to all parents for feedback on this event.
- 3.5 Eleven candidates attended a course leading to the National Pool Lifeguard Qualification during the months of February and March.
- 3.6 Derby Triathlon Club will be holding their annual event on 16th September this year. This is the largest and most prestigious pool-based triathlon event in the East Midlands, with athletes swimming 400m, cycling 18km around country roads, and finally tackling the 5km run finishing on the school playing fields.
