Please see below correspondence from Michelle Hazelwood (Gaunts). I have also spoken with Phil Tolley from the Union Pub Company,

As a result of these communications the premises application for the Alma Inn is to be amended to reflect the following:

- The terminal time for the service of alcohol will be Midnight Sunday thru Thursday, and 01:00hrs (1am) Friday & Saturday. The premises will remain open for a further 30 minutes each day to allow for dispersal.
- The premises may open for the service of alcohol until 01:00hrs on a Sunday and Monday of Bank Holiday weekends, Christmas Eve and Boxing Day. For New Years the premises may remain open from the terminal hour New Years Eve to the opening hour New Years Day.
- The non specific sporting extensions in Box M shall be restricted to 12 occasions per annum, on 14 days written notice to the police, and the police shall have right of veto on the grounds of contravention of one or more of the licensed objectives, such a right of veto not to be unreasonably exercised.
- The premises will comply with reasonable recommendations of the Police Crime Reduction Officer.
