If you want to make a complaint against any Member of South Derbyshire District Council or a Member of one of its Parishes, you will have to complete the necessary Complaint Form which is available from the Monitoring Officer and the Council's website (www.south-derbys.gov.uk).

The Standards Committee can only deal with complaints about the alleged behaviour and conduct of a Member. It will not deal with complaints about things that are not covered by the Members' Code of Conduct.
