1. PURPOSE

To determine an application for a premise licence received by this Authority on the 31st January 2013 from Mr Kamrul Hussain. **(application attached at Appendix 1)**.





APPENDIX 'A'

RE: SPICE TOUCH, Unit 4.

The applicant is applying for a Premises Licence for an on-licence establishment with the opening hours of the premise being 1700hrs to 2300hrs Monday and Sunday. The on-licence sales of alcohol would aim to replicate the opening hours of the Restaurant.

The purpose of the premises is to be an Indian Restaurant with the facility to sell alcohol by retail on the premises. The application for a Premises Licence would apparently be based on necessity of the overall offering with a view that the sale of alcohol would increase footfall, sales and revenue at the premise.

The premise is currently located within a small mall of newly built terraced units and is currently vacant. The premises are situated just off a main traffic island on the external portion of a newly built residential development. Within the small row of local business units are a convenience store and a fish and chip shop. This is only a short walk from a large residential area consisting of three storey town houses, shared housing and a Public House. On the same retail area that has communal parking is a local medical centre with varied opening times.

The premise would be frequented by the local community, those visiting the local area and those working within the area. The premise is also situated very close to late night bus stops that provide a link with the customers that will visit the Night Time Economy, both in Burton and Derby.

The behaviour of certain individuals when under the influence of alcohol is widely recognised and documented as being one of the main factors encouraging their anti-social behaviour and violence through the level of intoxication. My concern is that Adults and Children residing within the local area or attending the local educational establishments would be needlessly subjected to this unacceptable behaviour.

The premise would allow and through its offering, encourage more persons attend the area and this should be monitored stringently. Likewise the increase in transient custom will inevitably place a higher burden on the tidy up process within the immediate vicinity through the disposal of fast food wrappings. This in itself is a 'Public Nuisance' and could give rise to the decline in the image of a local convenience shopping area.

By applying for this licence I believe that it would lead to an increase in; litter, persons loitering and congregating and an increase in alcohol consumption within this residential and business area thereby giving cause for concern with regards to the support of the four Licensing Objectives;

Public nuisance
Public safety
Protection of children from harm
Crime and Disorder

It is my opinion that without being correctly supported with necessary, proportionate and appropriate conditions within the premises licence, there is the likelihood of the potential for Anti-social Behaviour and other crime that could be attributed to alcohol consumption, therefore undermining all of the licensing objectives.

Derbyshire Constabulary Licensing Department have been liaising with the applicant regarding the wording of suitable conditions to which they have agreed and believe that they are both supportive to the Licensing Act 2003 and the Licensing Objectives, whilst not being restrictive to the business operation. With this in mind should the application receive no other representations and be granted with the attached conditions the Chief Officer of Police would have no objections regarding the application?

Premises Licence Conditions for;

Spice Touch, Unit 4, Glamorgan Way, Church Gresley, Swadlincote.

Proposed by Derbyshire Police Licensing.

- 1. A 'Challenge 25' age verification policy will be employed at the premise with regards to the sale / supply of alcohol.
- 2. Clear signage in relation to the 'Challenge 25' age policy of the premises will be clearly displayed.
- 3. Any person who appears to be under the age of 25 years of age will be required to provide suitable proof of age before any alcohol is sold to them. This proof of age will be in the form of;
 - photo driving licence
 - current passport
 - Ministry of Defence identity card or
 - Government approved 'PASS' identification card scheme.
- 4. All requests for identification in relation to the sale / supply of alcohol will be entered in refusals books or registers kept for this purpose. These registers shall be kept on the premises for a minimum period of 1 year and will be produced upon request to a Police Officer or person as detailed within Section 13 of the licensing Act 2003.
- 5. Full training is to be provided to all staff on commencement of employment relating to all age-restricted products sold and any system or procedures they are expected to follow in the course of dealing with these goods. Records shall be retained on site and made available for inspection to a Police Officer or person as detailed within Section 13 of the licensing Act 2003.
- Alcohol shall only be sold / supplied directly to customers visiting the premises where the customer orders a substantial meal. This meal shall consist of several component parts. This should not be an 'individual' item of food stuff.
