1.0 Recommendations

1.1 That the final out-turn for 2001/2002 is approved.

2.0 Purpose of Report

2.1 To detail the Leisure Centre's actual out-turn for 2001/02 (with a comparison to the estimates) and to request each constituent partner to carry forward the net underspending in the year, to supplement the Centre's repairs budget in 2002/2003.

3.0 Executive Summary

3.1 The Leisure Centre's final out-turn shows a relatively small net underspending of £3,740 in 2001/2002 (compared to approved estimates). In addition, the Squash Courts generated additional net income of £1,816.

4.0 Detail

4.1 The final accounts are detailed in Appendix 1. It should be noted that the formal statement of accounts is awaiting audit, and will be reported to the next Committee when this has been completed.
