Following an assessment of the premises and its surrounding area the following is proposed:

30 minute "drinking up" time will allow appropriate dispersal, use of lavatories etc

In order to further the licensing objectives the licensee reserves the right to move the fire appliances, AWP machines, cigarette machines and or any other similar objects temporarily in a fixed location which may impact on the ability of individuals on the premises to use exits or escape routes without impediment.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

The pub is well-lit at the front and rear, the car park has additional lighting and the front also benefits from the on-street lighting from the highway. The only other pub, within the village, is the White Hart - which attracts a similar client base to our pub. Most customers live within the village and its hinterland.

c) Public safety

The chef holds a Basic Food Hygiene certificate. The premises benefits from emergency lighting and illuminated exit signs throughout. Fire fighting equipment are located in the catering kitchen, in the cellar, behind the bar and upstairs in the domestic accommodation. The disability discrimination act is being reviewed at this present time however, they have already installed access ramps from the rear car park into the lounge and are considering other ways to assist less abled persons at this time. The smoking charter has been considered and there will be no-smoking within the rear lounge area - whilst food is being served.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

This is a traditional village pub which rarely has live music - apart from village events such as Well Dressing, Fetes or Fun days - however, the building does retain sound because of its age and design. The departure of customers is well-managed and courteous - they are asked to drink up at last orders and depart in an amicable fashion within the regulated time - this will continue going forward. There are no adjoining local residents however, there are housing opposite and along the road.

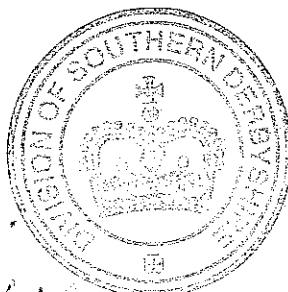

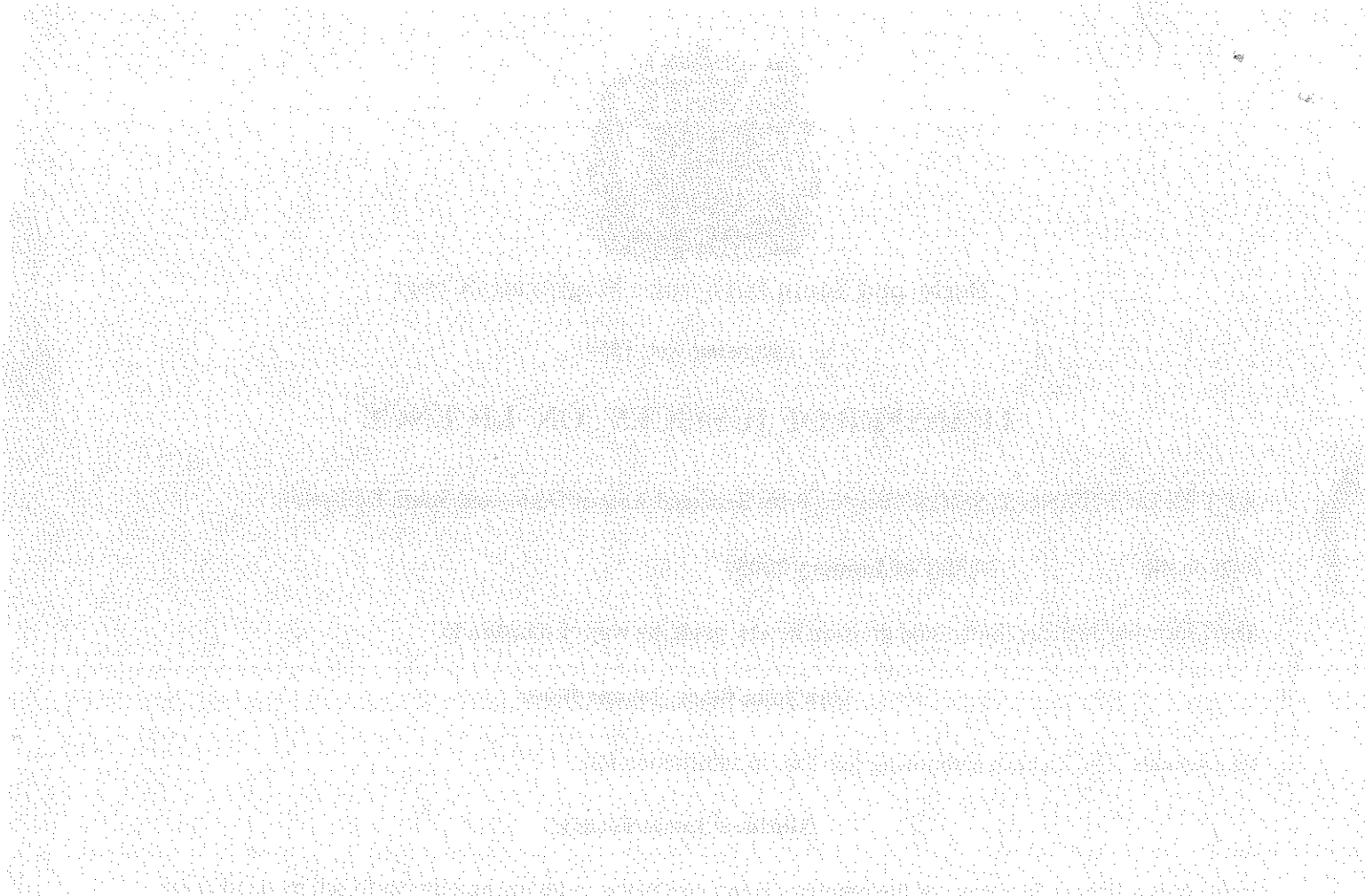
