This is a small family owned village public house and restaurant, reputedly one of the oldest buildings in the village. The present licensee is the owners son who supervises closely the joint managers (a husband and wife team) both of whom have licensing qualifications. The clientele is predominantly local and mature. The presence licensee applies regularly for extensions of hours as permitted by the Magistrates on Bank Holidays and similar occasions. Although the proposed variations if granted would enable the premises to open longer it is not intended that this should happen on a frequent basis, and overall the premises will continue to be run in much the same way as they always have been. Few if any additional steps are therefore considered to be necessary.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

With a clientele which is predominantly local and mature these have presented no great problem in the past and are not expected to in the future. The premises intend to remain a member of the local pub watch scheme. They do not go in for promotions such as cheap drinks or hours.

c) Public safety

The owners are confident that the premises comply with all present requirements and they intend that the premises should continue to do so. The premises have emergency lighting, illuminated exit signs, fire extinguishers, a fire alarm in the upstairs (non licenced residential accommodation, and appropriate certificates.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

Again with a predominantly local and mature clientele public nuisance has not been a past problem. Noise is kept down and so causes no problem. Very rarely has anything happened to cause neighbours concern and any concerns which are reasonably expressed will be met.
e) The protection of children from harm
The applicants repeat that the clientele are predominantly local and mature. This is not a public house which seeks to attract children on any pretext. It does not provide adult entertainment or anything of a similar nature.


