- That the Development Control Committee authorises the service of a Notice under 2.1 The provisions of Section 215 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 requiring the following steps to be taken to improve the condition of the land.

 - 2. The dumped litter and building materials to be removed.
 - 3. The overgrown grass and weeds to be cut, cleared and removed.

- Following a complaint, site inspections were carried out at the above location which is a roughly triangular area of land at the rear of a former newsagent's shop.
- The land was found to be badly affected by litter and overgrown vegetation and the 5.2 boundary fence and wall were in a dilapidated condition.
- 5.2 The registered owner has been contacted but has taken no action to tidy the land.
