1. PURPOSE

1.1 To determine an application for the grant of a premises licence received by the Licensing Authority on the 28th March 2017. A copy of the application is attached at **Appendix 1.**

2. BACKGROUND

2.1 The applicant is seeking a new premises licence to permit the sale by retail of alcohol for consumption on the premises and regulated entertainment including live and recorded music.

3. APPLICATION DETAILS

3.1 The applicant requests the Authority to permit the following:

5. AGREEMENT BETWEEN PARTIES

- 5.1 The applicant has agreed to have the conditions requested by Derbyshire County Council Trading Standards as shown at **Appendix 3** added to their licence.
- 5.2 Derbyshire County Council Trading Standards have subsequently withdrawn their representation as shown at **Appendix 4**.
- 5.3 All parties have agreed to dispense with the need to hold a hearing.

6. DETERMINATION

- 6.1 The power to grant licences in these circumstances remains with the Licensing and Appeals Sub-Committee.
- 6.2 As all parties have agreed to dispense with a hearing, there is no requirement to hear evidence, and Members are asked to grant the licence subject to such conditions contained in the operating schedule, together with proposed conditions from Derbyshire County Council Trading Standards and any mandatory conditions required under the Licensing Act 2003.

7. RIGHT OF APPEAL

7.1 The applicant or persons making representations have a right of appeal against the decision of the Licensing Authority.





Our participants safety and wellbeing is paramount to our planning. Our event plan, procedures and risk assessments will be in place and followed by all of our staff and contractors for the duration of the weekend. This is to ensure that we can prevent as much as possible any situation which may cause harm to our participants, contractors, staff or the general public. Should any situation arise, we will put our procedures into practice to deal effectively with the situation. All of our staff will be trained to know how to manage the situation in front of them.
b) The prevention of crime and disorder
We will not serve any individual who we deem to be intoxicated any alcohol. We also have a zero tolerance to illegal substances, including legal highs. Any participant found to be in possession of any drugs will be escorted off site by our security team immediately and the police will be notified.
c) Public safety
We will have an adequate number of security officers on site 24 hours per day to prevent, control and manage any situations which may arise including unruly and aggressive behavior. We will also have an adequate number of medics on site for the duration of the weekend who will obviously be on standby while the mud-run is under way to deal with injuries and incidents. The medics will also have a tent within the party village which participants could go to 24 hours per day should they need medical assistance.
d) The prevention of public nuisance
We will monitor noise throughout the weekend to ensure it does not disturb neighboring residents. Our stage manager and sound technicians will be responsible for keeping sound to a reasonable level. All music will be turned off at 23.00 each night.
e) The protection of children from harm
No children will be allowed on site. All participants will have to buy an entry ticket in advance or entry will be refused. Our entry tickets are only available to adults over the age of 18.
