<p>Domestic Burglary</p>	<p>➤ Burglary Reduction Project started. £110 000 of funding secured. Project has four aspects:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Alarms installed in victims homes 2. Security measures in homes of vulnerable people 3. Security measures around sheltered housing complexes 4. Security marking kits and alarms to all households <p>➤ Funding being allocated to assist the persistent offenders project</p> <p>➤ Community Drugs Officer researching the availability of current drug referral and treatment services in South Derbyshire. Revised procedures for referral now in place.</p> <p>➤ County Wide 'Foot in the Door' campaign – South Derbyshire event held on 21 November 2002.</p> <p>➤ Neighbourhood Watch support group re-launched. Each co-ordinator receiving a Security marking Kit.</p> <p>➤ Property Marking packs to be sent to every household in South Derbyshire, include voucher for free mini alarm and car window etching.</p>

New premises may be needed.
Autocrime	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Developing a multi-agency cross border crime prevention seminar for car park operators ➤ Beat constables have produced hot spot analysis of their areas which will be overlaid with other perceptions of levels of crime ➤ CCTV – £38,000 gained to joint fund 5 locations including: Greenbank Leisure Centre/Civic, Rosliston Forestry Centre, Welcome Break Service Centre, Little Chef (Willington) ➤ Successful Pre Christmas campaign aimed at supermarkets and car parks ➤ Development of 'Rat Trap' vehicle initiative. ➤ Auto Windscreens to provide free car window etching for residents in South Derbyshire.
