THIS APPLICATION IS FOR A PREMISE LICENCE COVERING LIVE AND RECORDED MUSIC, PERFORMANCE OF DANCE, LATE NIGHT REFRESHMENT AND ALCOHOL.

THE APPLICATION COVERS OPENING TIMES FINISHING AT 1AM ON EACH DAY OF THE YEAR.

THE PROPOSED WEDDING VENUE SITS IN AN ENTIRELY RURAL LOCATION, APPROXIMATELY 800 METRES ACROSS OPEN COUNTRYSIDE FROM THE VILLAGE OF HALBURY LEES. THE DISTANCE IS ACROSS A VALLEY WHICH WILL AMPLIFY NOISE TRANSFERENCE AND IS IN THE DIRECTION OF THE PREVAILING WIND. THEREFORE EVEN WITH A SOUND MANAGEMENT SYSTEM AS REQUIRED BY THE PLANNING APPROVAL, THERE WILL BE SIGNIFICANT ^{SOUND} TRANSFERENCE TO THE VILLAGE FROM MUSIC, GUEST NUMBERS, ETC. ESPECIALLY AS THE VENUE HAS OPEN AIR OUTSIDE FACILITIES.

AGAINST THIS BACKGROUND A PREMISE LICENCE UP TO 1AM ON A DAILY BASIS WOULD SEEM TOTALLY INAPPROPRIATE TO A RURAL ENVIRONMENT AND CREATE SIGNIFICANT AND INTOLERABLE ONGOING PUBLIC NUISANCE TO LOCAL RESIDENTS.

If possible please suggest alterations to the application that would resolve the problem mentioned above, again paying attention to the licensing objectives

OUR UNDERSTANDING IS THAT SURROUNDING LOCAL WEAVING VENUES HAVE LICENCES OPERATING UP TO 11.30PM. WITH TRANSPORT OFFSITE BY 12.00

THIS WOULD SEEM FAR MORE APPROPRIATE FOR A VENUE IN AN OPEN RURAL ENVIRONMENT IN CLOSE PROXIMITY TO A VILLAGE
