| <p><b>1 Chair's Introduction, Apologies</b></p>                              | <p>Janice Pallett welcomed everyone to the meeting and introductions were made from the panel.</p> <p>Apologies were received from South Derbyshire's new Inspector Nigel Lidsey.</p>  |
| <p><b>2 Minutes of last meeting (to be agreed) and update on actions</b></p> | <p>The minutes were agreed as a true record of the last meeting.</p>   |
| <p><b>3 Safer Neighbourhoods Sergeant's Overview / Priorities Update</b></p> | <p>Sgt Thompson ran through crime figures from April to the end of June 2013. These were compared to the same period in 2012.</p> <p>Violent crime has stayed the same<br/>           Domestic burglaries – none<br/>           Non dwelling burglaries have increased by 3 crimes<br/>           Other thefts have reduced by half<br/>           Vehicle crime has reduced by 80%<br/>           Damage has increased<br/>           Positive outcomes stand at 43% of all crime being detected.</p> |

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|                 | <p>Anti-social behaviour has reduced by 72 calls to service this year.</p> <p>Sgt Thompson discussed non-dwelling burglaries which had escalated in the Woodville area to 34 (compared to 15 last year). Officers had changed shifts in order to concentrate resources. The same individuals carrying out burglaries in Woodville were also involved in similar incidents in Area 6. Six youths have been arrested and are on bail, with two being charged. Officers are now trained to use the speed guns.</p> <p>There has been an increase in neighbour disputes recently in the area.</p> <p>Sgt Thompson urged residents to sign up to the Police's Community Messaging scheme in order to receive up-to-date information on incidents in their area.</p> <p>PCSO McMillan discussed local crime, confirming only 5 recorded so far this month.</p> <p>Rosliston suffered only 2 crimes in four months.</p> <p>ASB has been occurring at the MUGA in Overseal. The Police and Council Wardens are carrying out extra patrols.</p> <p>Speed checks have been carried out at various locations and people stopped and spoken to tended to live locally. Carrying out speed checks along Main Street Linton is difficult owing to parked cars.</p> <p>Police thanked a Castle Gresley resident for watering the flowerbeds throughout the summer.</p> <p>PC Crerar discussed speeding and restrictions.</p> <p>PCSO Dave McMillan informed the group that he produced a monthly crime report for Area 6, which goes out on the Community messaging scheme.</p> |
| <p><b>4</b></p> | <p><b>Partnership Update / Funding / New project ideas</b></p> <p>Phil Marriott discussed recent projects and initiatives run by the Partnership:</p> <p>There will be a number plate operation taking place at Gresleydale Health Centre, Church Gresley from 3 pm to 6 pm on 23<sup>rd</sup> September. Partnership staff and CVS will be fitting tamper-free number plate screws to vehicles free of charge.</p> <p>The Safer South Derbyshire Partnership has recently set up a Facebook page where local issues, forthcoming events and initiatives are posted regularly.</p> <p>The District Council's Sport and Health team have developed a leaflet advertising all the summer scheme provisions running over the school holidays. These were available for residents to take away from the meeting.</p> <p>Phil discussed dog control orders, which the Council's Safer Neighbourhood Wardens can enforce. These orders have been installed at various locations across the district.</p> <p>Further to requests from residents about dog fouling, Phil advised that the Wardens could also provide</p>   |

|                 | <p>'no dog fouling' stencils on footpaths in recreation grounds and parks. Contact Gareth Evans at the District Council.</p> <p>The Police 'Have your say' event is now available on-line to complete the survey. Monday 5<sup>th</sup> August is the deadline.</p> <p>Phil discussed Safer Neighbourhood funding and the availability of this for local community projects. Overseal Village Hall received funding for a CCTV system, which has improved security by 100%. Phil introduced Mr Bigg from Overseal Bowls Club who asked the group to approve their application for £1,000 towards a CCTV system to protect the bowling green. Mr Bigg gave a brief history of the club and that a fire in 2003 caused £19,000 worth of damage. In more recent times The meeting duly granted the funding.</p>   |
| <p><b>5</b></p> | <p><b>Local Issues – open forum (20 minutes)</b></p> <p>Resident raised that 32 ton skip lorries are using Bridle Lane in Castle Gresley, which is a bridle path to access a new site. Residents have taken registration numbers and photographs and reported this to the Police. Pedestrians have to put themselves into the hedge to let vehicles past. The issue was discussed and agreed to be raised at the Council Forum. PC Crerar and PCSO McMillan have attended this site and referred the matter to the Council.</p> <p>Residents from Greenacre Park have had eggs thrown at houses and issues with people playing golf adjacent to the park. Concerns are that someone or a property will be seriously damaged by a stray golf ball. Residents had reported this to Police and kept an incident log. PC Crerar confirmed that both himself and PCSO Dave McMillan had patrolled the area and visited in a marked car. No-one had been playing golf on these occasions</p> <p>Walton resident raised parking on pavements along Bells End Road. PC Crerar was aware of the problem.</p> <p>Coton resident raised that motorists were getting impatient when having to wait behind the school coaches and overtaking when it was not safe to do so.</p> <p>Parking issues were also raised in Coton Park with cars being parked fully on the pavements, pedestrians have to use the road. It has also been exaggerated by the Council re-roofing works in the area.</p> <p>Representatives from Overseal Gala Committee expressed their thanks to PC Crerar and PCSO McMillan for their hard work during the recent carnival.</p> |

LA/1. **APPOINTMENT OF CHAIRMAN**

It was noted that Councillor Wheeler had been appointed Chairman of the Linton Area Forum at the Annual Council Meeting.

**APOLOGIES**

Apologies for absence from the Meeting were received from H. Wheeler M.P. and M. Lacey.

LA/2. **APPOINTMENT OF VICE-CHAIRMAN**

It was agreed that Councillor Mrs. Hall be appointed Vice-Chairman of the Linton Area Forum for the ensuing year.

LA/3. **CHAIRMAN'S ANNOUNCEMENTS**

The Chairman referred to information leaflets that were available on summer activities and on safe use of the internet for social media sites. He also referred to an initiative in Rosliston for Community First Responders to provide local emergency assistance and further details could be obtained on this from the Parish Council's Chairman.

LA/8. **DISTRICT COUNCIL ISSUES**

The Chief Executive reported on the commencement of the “easy green recycling scheme”. Residents would shortly receive a green wheeled bin in which a variety of recyclable materials could be placed. He publicised road shows on 21st August in Rosliston and Overseal, at which residents could find out more information about the revised arrangements. It was questioned whether there would be a reduction in the number of recycling centres and this would depend on how well they continued to be used, once the new scheme had been introduced. A specific point was raised regarding the recycling arrangements at a village school and the risk of this being discontinued, because the school was not recycling enough.

A question was raised about the Council’s summer play scheme and the lack of adverting literature provided this year, which was noted by the Chief Executive.

**REPORT BACK ON ISSUES RAISED AT THE LAST MEETING**

At the last Linton Area Forum held on 24<sup>th</sup> July 2013, at the Rosliston & Cauldwell Village Hall, the following issues were raised and a progress report is provided.

**Derbyshire County Council Issues**

**1. BROADBAND CHAMPIONS MEETINGS**

Derbyshire County Council has now signed a contract with BT to roll out the Digital Derbyshire programme.

An update on the roll out of the programme and of the Champions meetings will be provided to the next forum.

**2. CADLEY HILL ROUNDABOUT**

An inspection of the carriageway surface revealed an area requiring urgent attention which was passed for repair.

The area's Maintenance Care Manager will be carrying out a follow up inspection with the local Highway Inspector to establish any further, more permanent works which may be required. The carriageway surface will continue to be monitored, and any actionable defects dealt with accordingly.

**3. 'THE SCOTTS', CASTLE GRESLEY**

The area Rights of Way Assistant advised that he will be looking into the possibility of having a fingerpost erected at the northern end of The Scotts, with another Road Traffic Act sign attached (the same as the sign erected at the southern entry). This is dependent on there being a suitable location to site the fingerpost.

In response to previous concerns raised at this forum the advanced weight restriction sign has been removed from the Hillside Road entry to the bridleway (to remove any confusion for drivers who might think this is a legitimate route through to the A444). Coupled with the installation of a further bridleway sign, drivers should be left in no doubt that this route is not suitable for motorised vehicles.

The existing signage at the A444/Mount Road junction already gives clear direction to drivers – a 'no through route' sign is provided, along with a sign to advise of the weight limit ahead. There is a further 'no through route' sign erected mid-way along Mount Road to act as a further reminder.

I would urge residents to take note of the registration number of any vehicles abusing the bridleway, where it's safe to do so, and report the matter to the local police.

#### **4. COTON PARK, LINTON: OBSCURED SIGNAGE**

This matter was passed to the area Maintenance Team, for action as necessary.

#### **5. CADLEY HILL ROAD, CADLEY HILL: CARRIAGEWAY FLOODING**

The gullies at this location were cleaned and jetted on 8 August 2013. Following which, the gullies were found to be running satisfactorily, flowing to the system in the centre of the road.
