Details of representation.....

Dear Members of the Licensing Authority I wish to object to the application of a beer garden/seating area, and licensable activities at the Assembly Rooms High Street Melbourne.

The reasons for my objections are as follows:

- 1 . Our four bedroom windows are directly above the proposed seating area.
- 2 . We already have to put up with foul language when events are held.
- 3 . Groups of party goers congregate outside the doors, our family are unable to sit in our seating area due to noise and very bad language.
- 4 . Children are in bed by 7:30 - 8:00pm with bedroom windows open for fresh air.

It goes without saying when people attend wedding parties etc, they get tanked up. With loud laughter, sometimes aggressive and argumentative behaviour, we already experience these side effects.

Over the past decade there has never been any door staff or requests for persons to leave the parties quietly.

It is with great sadness that I have to object as the application displays total disregard of our family dwelling and all who live here.

The bad language that we already hear is simply not fit for our young children, please do not allow this thoughtless, selfish and hair-brained idea to go forward.

If this application was unanimously agreed by the Assembly Rooms committee, shame on them. Please do not let them do it.

Someone needs to be a stabilising influence upon them.
