1.0 Recommendations

1.1 That a workshop for members of this Committee and the Tenants Advisory and Consultation Team is arranged in September to explore the detail of the Housing Revenue Account (HRA) Business Plan.

2.0 Purpose of Report

To consider actions designed to widen understanding of the HRA Business Plan and its role in helping the Authority clarify its vision and aspirations for its housing landlord service.

3.0 Detail

- As members are aware Local Authorities who have ownership of housing stock have to produce a 30-year Business Plan for their HRA as apart of the annual Housing Investment Programme.
- The Council's HRA Business Plan was submitted to GOEM at the end of July. A copy of the plan has been placed in the Members area.
- The Business Plan so far has been developed by Officers, with limited involvement by Members, tenants and front line staff.
- It is proposed that a series of workshops are held with members of this Committee, the Tenants Advisory and Consultation Team (TACT) and front line staff to explore the detail of the plan and to start developing the council's vision and aspirations for its Landlord service.
