





- The Designated Premises Supervisor will ensure that prominent, clear and legible notices are displayed at all exits to external areas requesting customers to respect the needs of local residents by keeping noise to a minimum. This is to include external drinking and smoking areas.
- 2. This message is to be emphasised by the Designated Premises Supervisor or nominated member of staff at closing time by requesting members of the public to leave the premises and area quietly.
- 3. When regulated entertainment involving amplified live / recorded music or speech is taking place at the premises all doors and windows will remain closed except for access and egress.
- 4. The Designated Premises Supervisor will ensure that after 2100hrs hourly checks are made around the boundary of the premises to check that noise levels from the premises are not at a level that could cause disturbance to neighbouring properties. (For the avoidance of doubt, if the music is able to be heard at each / any noise sensitive point it must be turned down to a point where it may not be heard).
- 5. These hourly checks are to be recorded within a log book specifically designated for this purpose and any action or findings shall be recorded at the point of the check.
- 6. The Designate Premises Supervisor shall receive and respond to complaints when activities involving amplified music or speech are taking place and during the time that customers are leaving the premises.
- 7. The Designated Premises Supervisor must take action to investigate the complaint and take reasonable steps to address the nature of the complaint.
- 8. A record of these complaints and of any action taken as a result shall be maintained in a log book kept specifically for that purpose. The logbook shall be made available for inspection by a Police Officer or an authorised officer as defined within section 13 of the Licensing Act 2003.
- 9. No customer shall be allowed to remove any alcoholic or other drink from the premises in an open container (glasses and open bottles) other than to an external area designated for consumption.
- 10. External areas will not be used after 2300 hrs except for parking, access and egress.

1. General Note: The minor variations process can only be used for variations that <u>could have no</u> <u>adverse impact on the promotion of any of the four licensing objectives</u>. (These are: the prevention of crime and disorder; public safety; the prevention of public nuisance; and the protection of children from harm.)

It cannot be used to:

- extend the period for which the licence or certificate has effect:
- · vary substantially the premises to which it relates;
- specify, in a premises licence, an individual as the designated premises supervisor
- add the sale by retail or supply of alcohol as an activity authorised by a licence or certificate:
- authorise the sale by retail or supply of alcohol at any time between 11pm and 7am;
- authorise an increase in the amount of time on any day during which alcohol may be sold by retail or supplied;
- include the alternative licence condition referred to in section 41D(3) of the Licensing Act 2003 in a premises licence.
- 2. <u>Description of premises</u>. For example the type of premises, its general situation and layout and any other information which could be relevant to the licensing objectives. BIIAB Level 1 Award in Responsible Alcohol Retailing (ARAR)

BIIAB has developed a new qualification in response to demand from the industry and its regulators to provide an assessed training programme for full and part-time staff working in all licensed premises. A replacement for the Barpersons National Certificate, the qualification is suitable for all areas of the licensed retail.

The curriculum includes:

- 1. The nature of alcohol, the common measurements of alcohol content and the effect that it has on the human body
- 2. The main issues in the 2003 Licensing Act as they relate to alcohol retailers and servers
- 3. The law and consequences of breach, in relation to the protection of children, the sale, consumption, and other activities, and recommended forms of proof of age within licensed premises.
- 4. The importance of contributing as a socially responsible team member with regard to the promotion and service of alcohol, the consequences of breach of the law, and strategies which will help the responsible drink retailer
- 5. How best to recognise and handle drunkenness of customers and the importance of doing so in relation to the law and the social responsibilities relating to the sale of alcohol
- 6. The potential causes of conflict and crime, appropriate strategies that can be adopted to prevent or eliminate these and the importance of personal safety

This half day course combines pre-course self-study and a face-to-face dassroom session, plus a 30-minute examination.
