

# RECORD OF DECISIONS

## ENVIRONMENTAL AND DEVELOPMENT SERVICES COMMITTEE

At the Meeting of the Environmental and Development Services Committee held on 12th July 2007, the following decisions were taken.

8.	<p><b><u>AGENDA ITEM</u></b> DECRIMINALISATION OF PARKING ENFORCEMENT.</p> <p><b>DECISION:</b></p> <p>(1) That the Council accepts Derbyshire County Council's proposals for the decriminalisation of parking offences.</p> <p>(2) That the Council commits to the use of a centrally procured service, managed by Derbyshire County Council, to process fixed penalty notices and to provide on-street warden services.</p> <p>(3) That the Heads of Environmental and Legal &amp; Democratic Services jointly examine the options to make the existing parking restrictions enforceable, within Council car parks, in anticipation of an enforcement presence.</p> <p>(4) That the Finance and Management Committee be recommended to include the sum of £6,266 in the 2008/09 budgets, to cover the initial set up costs and £4,200 in 2009/10 to cover a projected deficit, with anticipated net income of £634 in each subsequent year.</p>
