1.0 Recommendations

1.1 That approval is given to funding of £5000 per annum to the Asian Over 60's Club as a contribution to the provision of a focal point for the elders of the Asian community in Stenson Fields

2.0 Purpose of Report

2.1 To put in place arrangements for the council to contribute to the Asian Over 60's Club

3.0 Detail

- 3.1 A proposal for funding towards the Asian Over 60's Club was submitted by ward members as part of the 2002/3 budget process. Annexe A contains the members report on this issue
- 3.2 The proposal was considered alongside other budget proposals and was not built into the base budget for 2002/3 at this time
- 3.3 Members are now asked to reconsider this so that the future viability of the club and its services are supported by the Council
- 3.4 Community Services Committee considered this matter on 11 April 2002 and agreed to recommend to this committee that funding of £5000 per annum is provided

4.0 Financial Implications

- 4.1 A contribution of £5000 per annum to the club will need to be drawn from reserves and would have the effect of reducing balances by £15,000 over the three year planning term. This would result in projected balances at the end of 2004/5 of £760,000.
- 4.2 The predicted level of balances will be affected by the out-turn for the recent financial year (2001/2). The Council is beginning the close down process and the final out-turn will be reported to Finance and Management in July.
- 4.3 Depending on the reported out-turn the Finance and Management Committee may then wish to convene a second Service and Financial Planning Working Group to consider whether it wishes to allocate any surplus resources that arise at the out-turn stage.
- 4.4 Any contribution to the Asian Over 60's Club would be made as a grant and would be subject to ongoing support and monitoring of the grant as per support to other voluntary/community projects
