Response 1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Condition 30 conflicts with the condition in the home boarding conditions. The details should be of the dog day care rather than the owner. It should be the telephone number rather than the address. The details should be on the collar so that the premises don't have to buy too many tags. Condition 5 should allow puppies under 6 months to be on a premises if the owner has the experience and procedures in place to deal with a puppy 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Condition amended so that the details are on the collar of the dog day care establishment and that the details include the 'name and address or telephone number of the premises'. Condition from the home boarding establishment conditions added in to allow puppies under 6 months on the premises if the puppy has had its vaccinations and a socialisation programme is in place.
Response 2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Question to see if two licences will be required for home boarders who also offer day care. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> No amendments to the conditions
Response 3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Concerns over several proposals not being financially viable for a small home boarding establishment i.e. wood in home, coved junctions and kennel sizes. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The proposals mentioned were not intended to relate to home boarding establishments so the conditions have been amended to reflect this.
