 - 1. The storage container is permanently removed from the land.
 - 2. Any materials resulting from compliance with the above requirement are removed from the land.
 - 2.2 A compliance period of 28 days from when the notice takes effect is given.

5.0 Detail

- 5.1 Following a complaint alleging the unauthorised use of the property as a base for a builder's business, site inspections were carried at the above location.
- 5.2 Investigation revealed that there was no material change of use that would require the submission of a planning application but a metal industrial storage container was sited prominently on the eastern boundary of the property, occupying the site of a demolished garage.

- **5.3** The owner has been requested to either remove of regularise the siting of the container by application but has taken no action in the matter.
- 5.4 The southern portion of the site, which includes the area occupied by the container, is currently subject to an application for permission to erect two dwellings.
- **5.5** A plan of the site, which is approximately 430 square metres in area, is attached at Annexe A.

- 9.1 The storage container is unkempt in appearance, is prominent on the site and has a harmful effect on the amenity of the area.
