My partner and I have recently built a house in Dalby Lees. We choose to live in Dalby Lees to be away from busy, loud and built up areas. We live directly behind Gangeside's Farm around 750m away, along with my sister and brother in law next door.

Given the short distance and the horrendous wind on a daily basis I am concerned that we will all be kept awake by music and also people drinking and shouting rather loudly. This isn't ideal for anyone but I feel very strongly that this isn't suitable for three young children.

I think it is totally disrespectful for the venue to be allowed to serve alcohol or have music on after 11pm in the evenings considering the rural location and proximity to the houses.

If possible please suggest alterations to the application that would resolve the problem mentioned above, again paying attention to the licensing objectives

Licenses to limit the disturbance of our 3 children and myself to 11pm in such a rural and quiet location of Dalby Leas.
