	<p><b><u>DECISION:</u></b></p> <p>(1) That the contents of Derby City Councils and Derbyshire County Councils Draft Minerals Site Allocations – Aggregates – Development Plan Document be noted.</p> <p>(2) That Derbyshire County Council and Derby City Council, in their role as Minerals Planning Authority (MPA), be informed that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The District Council objects to the MPA preferred end date of the Plan being set at 2019, on the grounds that this is arbitrary. Extending the Plan period beyond the scope of existing sub-regional minerals apportionments, which currently cover the period 2001-2016 will lead to the allocation of additional sites without a sound understanding of actual future aggregates needs.</li> <li>• The District Council strongly objects to any future allocations around Elvaston on environmental and local amenity groups.</li> <li>• The District Council supports the continued emphasis on the need to make the best use of recycled and secondary aggregates, provided that sites are subject to strict environmental safeguards to protect local environments and communities.</li> <li>• The report be amended to include concerns on future restoration of land.</li> </ul>
