REPORT BACK ON ISSUES RAISED AT THE LAST MEETING

<u>1. PARKING AT THE JUNCTION OF CHURCH STREET AND THORPEDOWN ROAD,</u> <u>CHURCH GRESLEY – OUTSIDE TESCO EXPRESS</u>

2. 'NO-ENTRY' SIGNS ON ERNEST HALL WAY.

Ernest Hall Way is privately owned. The link from the adjacent High Street was block-paved by South Derbyshire District Council as part of the original Town Centre Pedestrianisation Scheme. The 'No Entry' signs were put up as part of that scheme.

To reinforce the no entry message, Derbyshire County Council will arrange for a 'NO ENTRY' carriageway marking to be placed where the existing tarmac surface meets the block paving. This should be completed shortly.
