<u>lssue</u>

The South Derbyshire Partnership has an available budget of £10,550 an allocation of which is requested to support the delivery of two projects.

Background

The District Council acts as accountable body for the South Derbyshire Partnership. This report outlines the Partnership's current financial position.

<u>Details</u>

There is currently £10,550 in the Partnership's Reserve which was carried over from previous years.

There are two requests for funding from this reserve. These are as follows:

Climate Week

To support a project to promote practical measures to save resources in line with national Climate Change Week, 21-27th March. Each day will have a theme, with associated activities, details tbc.

The events will demonstrate links between climate change, saving money, health and leisure activities. 90% of the work will be achieved by pooling resources and objectives. Support from SDP would enable additional work, for example bringing the 'Fantastic Homes' (energy saving) roadshow to the District as a focal point for activity.

Derby County FC : South Derbyshire Day

To support the delivery and promotion of the South Derbyshire Day at a home match at Pride Park. The funding to help achieve the attendance of up to 3000 residents of South Derbyshire who will spectate or be directly involved in a variety of activities on the day. Full proposal presented to the Board as part of a previous agenda item.
