DC/29. **REPORT OF THE HEAD OF PLANNING SERVICES**

DC/30. **PLANNING APPROVALS**

RESOLVED:-

That the following applications be granted, subject to the conditions set out in the reports of the Head of Planning Services and to any matters annotated:-

- (a) Demolition of existing dwelling and outbuildings and the erection of a new dwelling and carport together with the formation of vehicular access at The Gables, Kings Mills Lane, Weston-on-Trent (9/2008/0819/FM).***
- (b) The demolition of the garage adjacent to South Derbyshire Snooker Centre, Nos. 42-44 Grove Street, Swadlincote (9/2008/0872/CC).***

DC/31. **THE ERECTION OF A DWELLING AT THURVASTON STOOP, LONG LANE, DALBURY LEES (9/2008/0749/FM)**

 - (c) The proposed rebuilding of the former Burnaston House on land at Red Lane, Repton (9/2008/0840/L).*
- (2) That Members be authorised to consider any ancillary matters which might arise.*
- (3) That the local representatives be invited to be present in a representative capacity.*
