#### MATTER DELEGATED TO COMMITTEE

#### SC/38. REQUEST FOR DISPENSATION - BARROW-ON-TRENT PARISH COUNCIL

Members were reminded that on 26th November 2007, the Committee considered four requests received for dispensations under the Relevant Authorities (Standards Committee) (Dispensations) Regulations 2002 from Christine Barker, Anne Heathcote, Keith Slater and Ken Atkin, all Members of Barrow-on-Trent Parish Council. The requests related to a matter concerning the exhumation and reburial of William Henry Atkin and it was reported that as the Parish Council only had six Members, it was inquorate in considering the matter following the withdrawal of the aforementioned four Members. The Committee agreed that dispensations be granted to the four Parish Councillors to enable them to participate in decision-making on the matter concerned for a period of one year or upon the conclusion of the matter, whichever was the earlier.

Requests from Christine Barker, Anne Heathcote and Keith Slater for extensions to their dispensations were approved at the last Meeting of the Committee on 18th December 2008 for a further period of one year or upon the conclusion of the matter, whichever was the earlier.

An application had now been received from Ken Atkin, a copy of which was attached to the report. A copy of the Committee report on 2nd September 2004 on the procedure for dealing with dispensations was also circulated.
