1.0 Recommendations

- 1.1 That the Committee approves the list of designated polling places for the forthcoming Parliamentary Election.
- 1.2 That staff involved in the election be granted leave with pay at the discretion of the Chief Executive.

2.0 Purpose of Report

- 2.1 To review the list of designated polling premises and consider staffing implications relating to the forthcoming Parliamentary Election.

3.0 Detail

- 3.1 For each Election, the Council designates a list of premises to be used as polling stations. In preparation for the forthcoming Parliamentary Election, a review of polling places has been undertaken.
- 3.2 Members are asked to consider the proposed list of polling stations attached at Annexe 'A' and to approve these for use in the forthcoming Parliamentary Election.
- 3.3 In line with previous elections, Members are requested to consider granting staff involved in the manning of polling stations leave with pay.

4.0 Financial Implications

- 4.1 The costs of the Parliamentary Election will be funded by the Government.
