#### 4.0 Detail

- 4.1 Members of the Committee will be aware that recent changes have been made to the legislation that deals with allegations about the conduct of Councillors. Local authority Standards Committees became responsible for receiving complaints about Member conduct and deciding what to do with them. One option available to a Standards Committee after considering an Investigating Officer's report is to refer the matter to the Adjudication Panel for England for determination by a tribunal.
- 4.2 The President of the Adjudication Panel has issued guidance on the circumstances in which the Adjudication Panel would consider accepting a reference from a Standards Committee. A copy of the guidance is attached at Annexe 'A' for information.
