

Current policy;

- Owner/occupiers – not eligible unless problems with health & disability.
- Reasonable Preference Categories – currently other applicants have priority over applicants in RP Categories.
- Points System - is currently being used to allocate properties.
- Local connection – no local connection is needed to apply but actual allocation heavily weighted to local connection.
- Application process – commitment to reply in 10 days time.
- ASB – have to show 12 months change in behaviour to apply.
- Homelessness final offers – one offer only.
- Not included in policy – carelink details, list of RSL's, other housing options, making a complaint, details on cancelling application, changes in details, policy on by-passing applicants.
- Conviction of sex offences – clear policy written in to the allocations policy.

Appendix 2

GAP ANALYSIS OF SDDC current and proposed allocations policies

Proposed policy;

- Owner/occupiers – all can apply to go onto the waiting list.
- Reasonable Preference Categories – all the above categories to be given preference over any other category on the banding system.
- Banding System – is to be used to allocate properties.
- Local Connection – all can apply but if no local connection not eligible for some advertised properties.
- Application process – commitment to reply in 10 days time.
- ASB – each on it's own merits
- Homelessness offers – 3 months to bid, then will look at final offer.
- Included in policy – carelink details, list of RSL's, other housing options, making a complaint, details on cancelling application, changes in details, policy on by-passing applicants.
- Conviction of sex offences – not separate category, within general community safety heading.
