

**5.8. Licensable activities and times applied for and including amendments by applicants of the Black Cow during consultation.**

Provisions of regulated entertainment in respect to the provision of Indoor Sporting Events amended to Monday to Sunday 08:00hrs until 00:00 hours

Recorded Music, and anything that is similar in nature to the above activities amended to: - Monday to Sunday 11:00hrs until 00:00 hours

Live Music, indoors and anything that is similar in nature as application: -  
 Sunday to Thursday 11.00hrs until 23:00 hours  
 Friday and Saturday 11:00hrs until 00:00 hours

Provision of entertainment facilities which includes the provision of making music, dancing and anything that is similar in nature to the above activities as application, indoors: -

Sunday to Thursday 11.00hrs until 23:00 hours  
 Friday and Saturday 11:00hrs until 00:00 hours (**Appendix 1**)

The application also requests late night refreshment, indoors amended to: -  
 Monday to Sunday 23:00hrs until 00:00 hours

The application also requests the facility to use the external area and the provision of outdoor bar facilities (giving 14 days notice to authorities). Amended to be used for a maximum of 40 days per calendar year.

The application requests to extend the hours for the sale of alcohol indoors after amending: -  
 Monday to Sunday 11.00hrs until 00:00 hours

Outdoors: - Monday to Sunday 11.00hrs until 22:30 hours  
 With consumption in the external area to cease at 23:00 hours.
