Applications are invited from established, experienced and suitably qualified contractors for the provision of annual servicing, maintenance and breakdown repair of gas heating appliances and associated systems to both domestic (approx. 2900) and commercial (approx. 14) properties.

The contract will be for an initial three-year period commencing 1<sup>st</sup> April 2004, with an option for the contract to be either extended by a further two-year period. The extension to the contract will be assessed using key performance information collected and presented by the contractor on a monthly basis. The element of the contract for day to day responsive repairs and maintenance shall undertake a 24-hour/365 days a year call out service.

The contract covers both Council housing and public buildings, with an anticipated annual value of approximately £270,000.

All interested contractors must be CORGI and NICEIC registered and will have the facility to undertake all builders work in conjunction with the repairs and maintenance element of the contract.
